



High-Energy Astroparticle Physics at the University of Karlsruhe (TH)

The Centre of Excellence for Particle Physics and Astroparticle Physics (CETA) offers a post-doc position in the Pierre Auger Project starting September 1st, 2005. A successful candidate will be member of a *Helmholtz-Young-Investigators-Group*, which is funded by the Helmholtz Association of German Research Centres. The position is open to young researchers of any nationality. Applicants must have a Ph.D. or an equivalent degree at the time of recruitment.

The selected candidate is expected to carry out research in the context of the activities of the joint Auger groups of the Forschungszentrum Karlsruhe and University of Karlsruhe.

He/she should be experienced in experimental astroparticle physics and is expected to work actively on the analysis of the data. The candidate will participate particularly in the investigation of inclined extensive air showers.

Applicants should send (either electronically or via surface mail) a recent CV including a list of publications. He/she should also arrange for at least two letters of recommendation to be sent directly to the address given below.

Applications are accepted until the position is filled. Full consideration is given to all applications received before July 31, 2005. The starting date will be as early as possible in 2005 after August, 31st.
